Following this a selection process will take place and the successful applicants will then move to the first-round auditions and be asked to send a self-tape.

## Requests for self-tapes for first-round auditions by 17:00 on 19 August 2022

The self-tape will be of no more than 3 minutes. We would like to hear a recording of an unaccompanied song - something that demonstrates your vocal range and style of singing and also shows off your accuracy with rhythm and tuning.

Submission deadline for self-tapes: 17:00 on 22 August 2022

Notification of success to second- round auditions and arrangement of Zoom interviews from 25 August 2022

Second round auditions: 29 August 2022 on Zoom

Everyone will be informed by 12 September if they were successful or unsuccessful.

### **Further information**

- All first-round self-tapes will be watched by the Director
- All self-tapes of actors taken to second-round will be seen by the Director
- We commit to auditioning at least 6 actors who are currently unrepresented



- We will audition at least 25 actors for the entire project
- We will not be able to give feedback for first-round self-tapes
- Feedback will be provided for every second-round audition
- We will publish figures of how many people submitted first round self-tapes and how many actors were invited to the second-round audition
