

Walking to Pitlochry Festival Theatre from Pitlochry Station

Walking from Pitlochry Station to the Theatre is very simple and takes approximately 14 minutes.

The most accessible route crosses the Iron Suspension Bridge.

- Coming out of Pitlochry Station from the main exit by the Car Park, turn right and continue walking straight until you reach a T-Junction on Ferry Road, with Fern Cottage Restaurant directly in front of you.
- Turn right under the railway bridge.
- Once you reach a fork in the road opposite the Bridge Restaurant, turn left.
- Continue following the road round until you reach Pitlochry Recreation Ground.
- There is a small footpath just beyond the Recreation Ground on the left-hand side of the road, where the Theatre is signposted.
- Take this path and cross the Iron Suspension Bridge at the end of the path.
- Once you have crossed the bridge, there are two routes up to the Theatre, both of which are step free.
- You can either take the path in front of the Suspension Bridge which leads you up to the entrance, or you can follow the road to the right past the Port-na-Craig Inn, then take a path on the left which leads to the same entrance.
